

Matriculation

All postgraduate applicants, except those who are already graduates of Aberystwyth University are required to matriculate before being admitted for postgraduate study. In order to matriculate applicants must:

1 a. Have an undergraduate degree from an institution recognised by AU. Where applicants have not completed their degree at the point of application, this will be included as a condition of any offer made. A copy of the degree certificate and transcript will be required as proof of graduate status in order to complete the admissions process and subsequently register as a student.

or

1 b. Non-graduates who have at least 24 months of relevant professional experience can matriculate for Masters courses (but not PhD and PGCE programmes) on the basis of this experience. Non-graduation matriculation will be considered and approved by the relevant departmental Postgraduate Selector prior to a conditional offer being made.

2. The main resource for evaluating non-UK qualifications is UK NARIC. Both the qualification level and recognition of the awarding HEI are checked. The grade comparisons used by Aberystwyth University are derived from NARIC information in conjunction with information used by other HEIs.
