- 3. In the 1930s artist Stanley Anderson wrote that 'great art stands one hundred men deep'. What do you think he meant? Is it relevant that artists today know about and learn from tradition?
- 4. Why do you think that Impressionist paintings continue to capture the public imagination almost one hundred and fifty years since the first Impressionist exhibition?
- 5. How might you help a friend understand a piece of abstract art?
- 6. What is the difference between art and craft, and artist and a craft maker?
