- 3. Describe the processes that occur when two tectonic plates collide.
- 4. Describe the internal structure of the earth.
- 5. Describe how metamorphic rocks are formed and how they are classified.
- 6. Describe the stratigraphic and structural context in which hydrocarbon reservoirs are formed.
- 7. Describe the processes that lead to the preservation of fossils.
- 8. Explain how the study of modern sedimentary environments can help us understand ancient sedimentary deposits.
