## Instructions to candidates: you must answer 2 questions from a choice of 10.

- 1. Drawing on specific examples, discuss how notions of the self are defined through reference to an 'other'.
- 2. Evaluate the extent to which globalisation is changing individual and group identity.
- 3. Using specific examples, discuss how a sociological approach might help us understand the relationship between power and resistance.
- 4. How does social change come about?
- 5. The UK's policy of multiculturalism has failed. Discuss.
- 6. How does a sociological approach help us to understand how social inequalities are created and the ways in which they might be alleviated?
- 7. What are the key institutions that help to define social categories? Use the example of EITHER gender OR race in your answer.
- 8. Discuss how a sociological approach might help to improve one area of public policy in the UK.
- 9. In your opinion, which philosopher has made the most significant contribution to our understanding of Sociology and sociological issues? Justify your choice.
- 10. Former Prime Minister of the UK, Margaret Thatcher, maintained that there was no such thing as society. Write an essay that supports her argument, drawing on specific examples.
