Answer TWO questions.

- 1. What do you understand by the term 'applied theatre'? Refer to specific examples to support your answer.
- 2. What do you understand by **two** of the following terms: realism, naturalism, expressionism, theatre of the absurd and/or post- dramatic theatre? Where appropriate you should refer to play texts, productions or performance events you have seen to illustrate your answer.
- 3. Performance. Theatre. Drama. Are they all the same thing? If not, how are they different?
- 4. Describe how you might devise an ensemble piece based around a particular theme of your choice. You must include how you would undertake research, devising processes, rehearsal strategies, audience and staging.
- 5. Discuss the work of <u>two</u> contemporary theatre practitioners/companies/playwrights that you find interesting. You should refer to specific texts or performances to illustrate what is distinctive about their work.
- 6. What is the relevance of theatre for today's society? Is it still relevant? Discuss.
- 7. It has been suggested that William Shakespeare's plays still have relevance for contemporary society. Referring to specific plays and contemporary productions of Shakespeare's work, discuss why he has remained a persistent figure in theatre.
