Answer two questions

- 1. Children should follow a play-based curriculum until they are 7 years old. Discuss the advantages and disadvantages of this statement.
- 2. Parents and family play an important role in education, and should be involved in decisions made in schools. Discuss whether you agree or disagree with this statement.
- 3. Schools are able to influence the contents of children's lunchboxes. Discuss the arguments surrounding this issue.
- 4. The content of the National Curriculum should be the same for every UK country (England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland). Discuss the main issues on both sides of this debate.
- 5. Present a case for the inclusion of a subject or topic in the National Curriculum, which is not currently present. Justify your choice.
- 6. A pupil's final grades in school should be decided by teacher assessment rather than formal exams and coursework. Discuss whether you agree or disagree with this statement.
- 7. Outline the strengths and weaknesses of teaching in mixed-age groups.
- 8. Literacy and Numeracy are the most important topics in primary and secondary schools. Discuss whether you agree or disagree with this statement.
- 9. Do you think that boys and girls should be taught separately for certain subjects? Why?
- 10. Discuss the arguments for and against the reintroduction of grammar schools.
