You must produce a response to <u>ONE</u> of the following questions. Candidates are advised to think carefully and to write clearly. You may not bring texts into the Examination.

Answer <u>ONE</u> of the following questions illustrating your answers with close reference to <u>TWO</u> texts (of any genre) of your choice.

- 1. Explore the treatment of home <u>AND/OR</u> family in any <u>TWO</u> texts.
- 2. 'Literature plays an active part in history and is bound up with its surrounding historical contexts'. Discuss this statement in relation to any **TWO** texts.
- 3. 'Gender is not fixed; it is as fluid and moveable as any other part of our identity' Consider the relevance of this statement to any **TWO** texts.
- 4. Discuss the ways in which any <u>**TWO**</u> texts seek to challenge the reader's preconceptions.
- 5. Explore the treatment of <u>ONE</u> of the following pairs of themes in any <u>TWO</u> texts:
 - Speech and silence
 - War and peace
 - Self and other
 - Art and nature
 - Human and non-human
